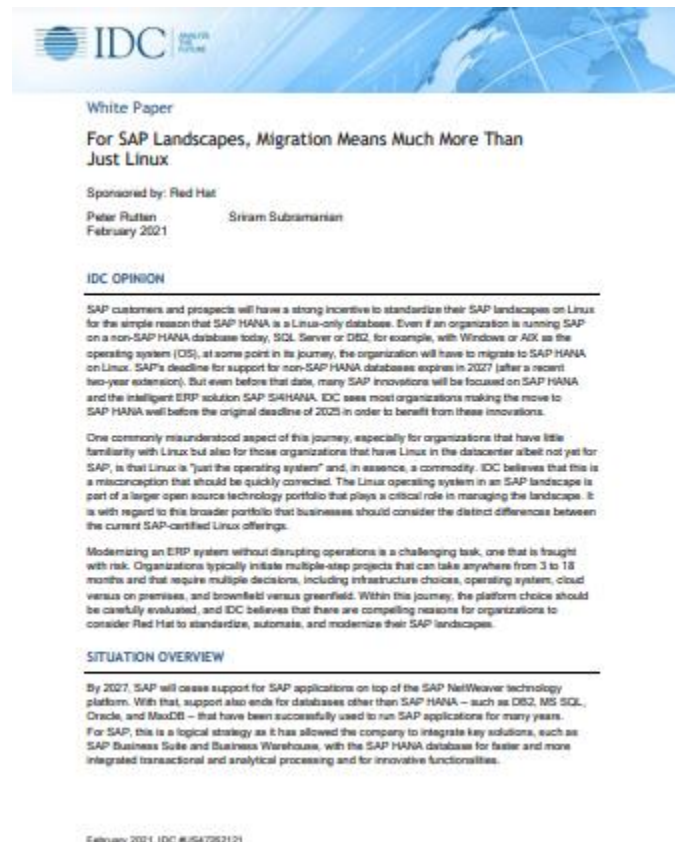


For SAP Landscapes, Migration Means Much More Than Just Linux
